

Norfolk Island Has been listed

On the 10 December 2018 the U.N. human rights committee recognised the issues as raised in Norfolk island's/Albert Buffett's petition, this means we are now recognised within the U.N. OHCHR as having a grievance claim whereby Australia has breached the articles of the international covenant of civil and political rights.

To use the words of Geoffrey Robertson AO QC; Australia now has 6 months to defend its actions to the human rights committee, in accordance with rule 97 of the committee's rules of procedure.

Geoffrey Robertson AO QC states, "that the case will have important consequences for international law and the case will emphasise the importance of indigenous people - like the Australian aborigines - having a voice and some say in issues that affect them".
